The petitioners seek directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty.

The petitioners are in live-in-relationship. Petitioner No.1 is minor. As the parents of petitioner No.1 were forcing her to get married against her wishes and to avoid such a situation, she opted to live with petitioner No.2, till the time she becomes major. The petitioners are now being threatened by the private respondents and they fear for their life.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2, to objectively consider the representation dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to provide necessary protection to the petitioners in case it is felt necessary. This order however, shall not be construed as a restraint on registration of a criminal case, in case the same is necessitated in the surrounding facts and circumstances of this case.
