GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The learned counsel *inter alia* contends that the complainant in his complaint has arrayed one M/s Lotus Builders and Refiniers as accused No.1 and Seema Sharma and Arun Sharma being its directors as respondents No.2 and 3, whereas, in fact the petitioner has nothing to do with the aforesaid M/s Lotus Builders and Refiniers and to his knowledge such firm or company is not existent.

The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the points taken herein before the trial Court so as to seek his discharge. The presence of the petitioner shall, however, remain exempted provided he furnishes an undertaking that he shall be duly represented by a counsel and will have no objection for examination of the witnesses even in his absence provided the evidence is recorded in the presence of his counsel and shall appear as and when directed by the trial Court and abide by any other condition as may be imposed by the trial Court.
