Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.862 dated 2.11.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 34, 365, 379-A IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Present FIR is an out-come of sudden quarrel, in fit of anger and some misunderstanding. Now, by the intervention of the respectable friends, matter has been compromised.

3. Parties have entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-2. This Court by order dated 25.01.2018 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sirsa and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 08.02.2018 from which it is evident that compromise Annexure P-2 is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. In view of the law laid down in **Anita Maria Dias and another**

v. **State of Maharashtra and another**; (2018) 3 SCC 290, no useful purpose

would be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the

present petition is allowed and FIR No.862 dated 2.11.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 34, 365, 379-A IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioner. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury Sirsa District, State of Haryana, within a period of three months from today.
