The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.143 dated 18.07.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court vide Settlement/Agreement dated 09.01.2018 and as per the said compromise, the parties are residing together. It is also submitted that a petition for quashing of the aforesaid FIR has already been preferred.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised between the parties and pursuant to the compromise, they are residing together and a petition for quashing of the instant FIR has already been preferred, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 28.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
