This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.138 dated 14.07.2017 under Sections 381, 511, 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On 17.01.2018, this Court has passed the following order:-

“The allegations are with regard to an attempt having been made to break/tamper with the A.T.M.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from H.C Bhupinder Singh concedes that no money actually had been stolen.

List on 5.3.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Harpal Singh informs the Court that petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 17.01.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.
