Petitioner-Sunny Sood has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 09.02.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued.

On the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. A.G., Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per order dated 11.07.2018, the present petitioner, who was on regular bail, absented himself from the Court proceedings and non-bailable warrants were issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the absence of the petitioner was not intentional. Otherwise also, challan has been presented and the case is at the preliminary stage.

Therefore, keeping in view the above facts and circumstances

and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. I accept this criminal miscellaneous petition and it is ordered that the petitioner will surrender before the learned trial Court within seven days from today and the learned trial Court will release him on bail to its satisfaction.
