Pursuant to the order dated August 8, 2018, a copy of the report of the Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban, has been produced in Court today by the learned State counsel, in which it is stated that the tests were positive on the presence of “Tetrahydrocannabinol, Cannabinol and Cannabidiol in the samples”. It is also stated that characteristics of trichomes of *ganja* were present in sample nos.1 to 14 and therefore the tests were positive for presence of *ganja* in the said samples.

That being so, and the quantity stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the prosecution) being 140 kgs of *ganja*, I see no reason to grant him bail at this stage.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.

However, nothing stated hereinabove will be taken to be an observation of this Court on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner.
