ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0006 dated 09.01.2017, registered under Sections 346 IPC (wherein later Section 346 IPC was deleted and Sections 363, 366-A IPC were added) at Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2017 and in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the girl had made a statement in his favour and she had refused her medical though at the trial she has supported the prosecution story and 10 witnesses out of 17 have been examined and the case was fixed for remaining evidence for today before the trial Court.

The victim has already been examined at the trial. The petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2017.

Trial is taking time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with a condition that the petitioner would not contact the victim during the pendency of the trial.
