Affidavit of Sh. Jashandeep Singh Randhawa, IPS,
Superintendent of Police, Rohtak has been filed in the Court today.
Same is taken on record.

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of
the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case
FIR No.173 dated 04.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sampla,
District Rohtak, under Sections 302, 120-B, 476 and 34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has
appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that all the private witnesses including eye-witnesses have been recorded before the trial Court and they have not supported the prosecution version and have turned hostile.

The petitioner has been in custody since 19.05.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
