In the present petition, petitioner seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.41 dated 02.03.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1).

2. This Court vide order dated 02.08.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gian Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 02.08.2018 the petitioner has joined investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 02.08.2018 have gone un rebutted.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without

expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 02.08.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial. This order would not come in the way of his custodial interrogation in any other matter.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
