The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 22 dated 02.06.2018 under Sections 376, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.

Mr. Harish Sharma, Advocate has appeared and filed his vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, he has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 02.08.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
