The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.12 dated 19.01.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Patiala, under Sections 323, 341, 342, 452, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 02.08.2018, report dated 17.09.2018 has been received from the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
