The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to official respondents to hand over the investigation of the case FIR No.142, dated 20.04.2018, registered at Police Station City, District Barnala, under sections 304-A, 279, 427 IPC to some Senior Officer outside the District of Barnala.

Reply dated 31.08.2018 has been filed by way of affidavit of Sh. Harjit Singh, SSP, Barnala, District Barnala. The contents thereof shows that two enquiries were conducted in the aforementioned FIR and in both the enquiries, it has been found that Kuldip Singh son of the petitioner caused death of the nephew of respondent No.6 due to an accident with the combine owned by the petitioner. It is also stated that respondent No.5 was not associated with either of these enquiries.

In view of the aforementioned affidavit, it cannot be said that the enquiry conducted by the Police is biased. Thus, there is no merit in this petition and the same is dismissed.
