The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.81 dated 14.7.2018, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, Police Station Kot-Ise-Khan, Moga.

The dispute in the present case is of an amount of ₹1.30 lacs which as per case of the complainant is an amount to be paid by the accused to the complainant on account of use of truck of the complainant.

Today at the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel as has been stated so upon instructions from ASI Mukhinder Singh.

Bearing in mind the nature of offence and also the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is as such accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 2.8.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed and would fully cooperate with the investigation.
