Petitioner Shahjad @ Sajji has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.381 dated 24.06.2018, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, under Sections 379-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case has been registered on the statement of Sajid Hussain. As per him, at night he found two persons in his house taking away LCD, mobile phone OPPO F.05, purse and other jewellery. He apprehended those persons, but later on, they pushed him and ran away with said articles. As per the FIR, the complainant put suspicion on Yusuf and Iklas. As per the allegation, the stolen LCD had been purchased by the present petitioner and the same has been recovered from

him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 25.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
