The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.105, dated 03.06.2017, under Section 21/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.

As per prosecution version, based on secret information, a police party had intercepted a scooter driven by Sohan Singh @ Sukhdev Singh with pillion rider, namely, Raj Kumar @ Raja. The alleged recovery effected from the afore mentioned two accused was 500 grams of heroin from Sohan Singh and 300 grams of heroin from Raj Kumar @ Raja.

Petitioner is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused Sohan Singh.

There is no recovery effected from the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Jagir Singh concedes that both Sohan Singh and Raj Kumar @ Raja have been granted benefit of regular bail.

The present petitioner is stated to be not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented.

Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

In view of the discussion above and without making any observations on merit, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

Disposed of.
