DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0073 dated 13.4.2017 registered under Sections 406,420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no specific allegations against the petitioner and he is not named in the FIR. The story of the prosecution does not appear to be believable, as why a person who is businessman, would give the amount to the petitioner. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation.

Heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the

petitioner and have also gone through the contents of the FIR and other documents available on the file.

Admittedly, co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Harjinder Singh @ Bhalwan @ Bhau approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail by way of filing Crl. Misc. No. M-8778 of 018, which was dismissed on 9.3.2018. Allegations against the petitioner and co-accused are same and the petitioner has also been named in the FIR.

Since petition filed by co-accused has already been dismissed by this court on 9.3.2018 and the allegations against the petitioner and co-accused are same, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
