Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 47 dated 28.5.2018 under sections 364, 143, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

It comes out that present case was registered on the complaint made by Paramjit Singh, who stated that on 19.5.2018, he came to the District Court Complex, Fazilka to seek protection from the Court after getting married to Sapna. In the Court complex, 3-4 persons forcibly kidnapped Sapna at about 3.30 P.M. During the course of investigation, statement of Sapna had been recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fazilka on 15.6.2018.

In her statement, she stated that she was not kidnapped rather she has herself slipped away and went back to her home.

Present petitioners are stated to be the member of the said group of 3-4 persons, who allegedly kidnapped Sapna.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 2.8.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
