Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the order dated 12.12.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) Nos. 10799-10800 of 2018 which is reproduced below:-

“ The learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the interim order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Nagpur Bench in Criminal Writ Petition No. 866 of 2018 on 10.09.2018 giving interim relief in terms of Clause (C) was submitted before the Court, in which there is stay of further proceedings pursuant to the FIR. Thus, the High Court should not have asked the petitioner to join investigation in view of the order passed by the learned single Judge in the aforesaid writ petition.

The statement is placed on record.

The learned senior counsel seeks leave to withdraw these Special Leave Petitions and also the bail application which was filed before the High Court in view of the interim order passed by the High Court in writ petition on 10.09.2018.

Liberty is granted to withdraw these Special Leave

Petitions as well as the application filed before the High Court.'

The Special Leave Petitions and the bail application are, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.”

Thus, this petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
