ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking transfer of the investigation of his case lodged on his behest.

The petitioner claims that he is living in Palwal and the distance to the Jhajjar Court would be more than 100 kilometers and the accused persons are politically strong and therefore, the FIR which has been registered on his behest and the trial should be transferred out of district.

The petition does not disclose any specific reason for transfer. The petitioner only states that the other side is politically strong. No details have been given. The incident had occurred in the Jhajjar and the FIR was promptly recorded. As per the contents of the petition, the matter is before the Additional Sessions Judge. The petitioner has not been able to make out any case for transfer. There are no allegations of *mala fide* against any police officials.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
