This is third petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.95 dated 07.07.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Amloh District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner is facing number of prosecutions for duping the gullible investors and others in multiple number of States, including Punjab where there are said to be 13 FIRs against him. There are more FIRs in the States of Maharashtra and other States as well.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that his properties have been attached and therefore, there is no need to keep him in custody.

I do not agree with the counsel for the petitioner as the petitioner has duped several innocent persons of their hard earned money and cannot be given premier by releasing him on regular bail.

In that view of the matter, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Hence I make the following order:
