The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 18.6.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Heard.

The allegation against the petitioner is that on 18.6.2018, complainant Smt. Leela Rani was having an amount of ₹ 1,25,000/- with her which was snatched by the petitioners. They were apprehended at the spot and the amount has been recovered.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time and the fact that all the petitioners are women and out of them one lady is having a child of 1½ years in her lap which was also in jail with her, the

present petition is allowed. Petitioners-Chanda wife of Shri Gautam, Janu wife of Shri Jitesh, Priya daughter of Takhat Singh and Kajal daughter of Manoj are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
