GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.70 dated 16.5.2018 registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana under Sections 452, 341, 323, 324, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 2.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal has been received to the effect that the statements of petitioners/accused Baljit Singh, Rajvir Singh and Parmeet Singh as well as complainant Jasbir Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.70 dated 16.5.2018 registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana under Sections 452, 341, 323, 324, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
