Petitioner Ajij @ Ajji has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.203 dated 28.05.2017, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh, under Sections 332, 353, 186 and 307 IPC and under Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegation, when the police party went to arrest the present petitioner in a murder case on the basis of secret information then the present petitioner along with co-accused fired on the police party. It is a no injury case.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.08.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
