Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 22.12.2017 passed by learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, whereby the petitioner has been declared as PO and notice has been issued to the surety.

Vide order dated 07.11.2017, Judge Special Court had issued proclamation of the petitioner along with the other co-accused for 29.11.2017 and thereafter, vide order dated 29.11.2017, while issuing process, the trial Court adjourned the case to 22.12.2017. It is on 22.12.2017, the trial Court has declared the petitioner as Proclaimed Offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from the fact that Section 82 of Cr.P.C. has not been legally adhered to, petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and to face trial. In fact, he has

Without observing anything on the merits of the case but
considering the fact that the petitioner has shown his inclination to surrender
before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law, the present
petition is hereby disposed of at this stage, with a direction that in case the
petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today and
furnish an undertaking that he will continue to appear before the trial Court
and shall not cause any delay in the smooth trial of the case, he shall be
admitted on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds
and a local surety, however, that would be subject to payment of Rs.10,000/-
to the deposited with the Punjab Legal Services Authority.
