Despite the case having been called twice, the petitioner has gone un-represented.

Learned counsel for complainant-Mahant Divyamber Muni, has filed power of attorney on his own, though he has not been impleaded as party. The same is taken on record. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Perusal of the file shows that earlier on two occasions when this case was taken on Board for hearing, the petitioner has gone un-represented.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant submits that filing of instant petition by the petitioner is a gross abuse of the process of law, inasmuch as, similar bail application has been filed by the petitioner before the lower Court, which was pending

adjudication for 23.09.2018.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed on the following two counts:-

- (i) for want of prosecution; and
- (ii) on the ground of abusing the process of law.
