In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“Petition U/s 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to respondent No.2 to submit the status report in the case FIR No.84 dated 7.11.2016 under Section 70 of Northern India Canal and Drainage Act, 1873, P.s. Kotbhai, District Shri Muktsar Sahib as the officials respondent No.3 in connivance with the accused persons has failed to take any action in the aforesaid FIR and till today neither any arrest has been made nor any investigation has been carried out inspite of various reminders sent by the petitioner to respondents No.2 and 3 through representations. Further, for a direction to respondent No.2 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of the accused persons or anybody else on their behest, who are openly threatening to kill the petitioner. With the further prayer for a direction to respondent No.2 to take action against respondent No.3 for not performing his duties as he due to the political influence of the accused party intentionally is not taking any action against the accused persons.”

2. During the pendency of the present petition, official respondents were stated to have filed closure report dated 3.10.2018 before

the court below. Petitioner is permitted to file protest application before the court below.

3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition do not survive for consideration.

4. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
