Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No.53 dated 29.09.2015, filed by respondent no.2 under Sections 452/354/379/34 IPC, before the SDJM, Baba Bakala, in which the petitioner has been summoned to face trial.
