Prayer in this petition is for registration of an FIR on the basis of representation dated 05.08.2017 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner.

As per status report dated 01.11.2017, FIR No. 60 dated 07.10.2017, has been registered under Section 498-A IPC against Rahul Bagga and Nikhil Bagga.

Learned counsel for the State informs that the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., has also been presented.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the abvoesaid FIR has been registered, the accused are not being proceeded against for all the offences committed by them. However, in view of the registration of FIR in the present case as well as presentation of challan, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to them in accordance with law.
