Jaswinder Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking two reliefs; one, quashing of FIR No.31 dated 14.4.2015, under Section 381 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1); second, quashing of order dated 05.4.2016 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, declaring the petitioner as a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has submitted himself before the Court on 06.12.2016 and the challenge to the order dated 05.4.2016 is now rendered infructuous.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Singh

has apprised the Court that after completion of the investigation, final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has been submitted before the competent Court on 05.6.2017.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to raise all these pleas before the competent Court at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
