Petitioner Deepak has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 07.08.2014, registered at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 302, 212 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was on regular bail and had to appear before the trial Court on 11.04.2018, but he was arrested in another case on 10.04.2018. His absence from the Court was not intentional, but due to the above stated reason.

The petitioner has been in custody since 14.05.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping

the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
