Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to act on FIR No.208 dated 07.06.2017 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the said FIR was registered on 07.06.2017 but no follow up action has been taken so far. The petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P-2), but even that representation goes un-addressed. She states that at this stage limited prayer of the petitioner is to direct the respondents to expedite the investigation.

Noticing the fact that FIR was registered on 07.06.2017 though it is but presumed that the police must have conducted the investigation, however, without observing anything on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to expedite the investigation.
