Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0310 dated 02.06.2018 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149, 307, 427, 506 of IPC at Police Station City Fatehabad, Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 02.08.2018, petitioner was granted ad-interim bail, subject to the condition that he shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, the petitioner did join the investigation and accordingly, vide order dated 01.10.2018, he was again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the orders dated 02.08.2018 and 01.10.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 02.10.2018 and recovery of kapa has been effected from him. He further states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the orders dated 02.08.2018 and 01.10.2018 are made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
