1. In the present petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 75 dated 26.06.2018, under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

2. It is submitted that co-accused of the petitioner has been extended the benefit of regular bail. Moreover, both the parties i.e. petitioner and complainant are blood related persons. The alleged incident is relating to land dispute. That apart an affidavit has been filed by the complainant to the extent that they have entered into a compromise.

3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, petitioner – Jatinder Singh is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate.

4. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

5. Petition is allowed accordingly.
