The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.228 dated 30.8.2016, under Section 326-A IPC, Police Station Sultanwinde, Amritsar, apprehending their arrest on account of Nonailable Warrants having been issued by the trial Court while accepting an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning the petitioners to face trial as additional accused along with the other accused who had already been challaned.

Vide order dated 3.8.2018, the petitioners had been directed to appear before the learned trial Court and the trial Court had been directed to release the petitioners on interim bail.

It has been stated at bar by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners have already appeared before the learned trial Court and have been released on interim bail.

Since, it is a case where the petitioners have been summoned with the aid of Section 319 Cr.P.C. it goes without saying that they are not required for any investigation at this stage. In my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is as such accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 3.8.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall keep on appearing before the learned trial Court regularly and shall abide by any such condition, as may be imposed by the learned trial Court.
