Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.24 dated 11.05.2018 under Section 420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 10.08.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that the petitioner has compromised the matter with the complainant and has filed CRM-M-43721-2018 for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise and the same is now pending for 25.01.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
