The petitioner prays for direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty as well as that of her minor children.

It is alleged that the petitioner is in a long standing dispute with her husband and father in law (respondent Nos.4 and 5, respectively). Cases are also pending in the civil Court. However, during the pendency of the civil cases, the petitioner has left the matrimonial home and is now residing separately with her children. She and her children are being threatened by respondent Nos.4 and 5 and despite representation dated 29.07.2018 (Annexure P6), the police is not protecting them.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 and 5, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P6) and to take

appropriate action, in accordance with law, if found necessary. Meanwhile, it shall be ensured that no harm comes to the petitioner and her children.
