This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing to the trial Court to expedite the trial in a time bound manner in Complaint No.RBT-12/12.12.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that even though the complaint has been filed as far back as on 12.12.2018, as on date the evidence in the matter has not commenced and that the complainant is delaying the said proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and taking note of the fact that the matter is pending since 12.12.2016 and as on date

the evidence has not commenced, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to the JMIC, Moga to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible.

The petition stands disposed of in the above said terms.
