ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 298 dated 18.8.2017 registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat, Haryana under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since October 2017 and the private witnesses have been examined and they have not supported the prosecution version. He refers to the statements available on record.

State counsel submits that all the private witnesses including the complainant have not supported the prosecution version. It is stated that the mother was not cited as a witness in this case.

In view of the above and without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released

on bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
