The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 428 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life at the behest of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

As per matriculation certificate (Annexure P-2), the date of birth of petitioner No.2 Gurpreet Kaur is 21.07.2001. Thus, she is under 18 years but she claims to be 17 years of age. Further, case of the petitioners is that they have married with each other on 01.08.2018 i.e. during the minority of petitioner No.2 Gurpreet Kaur.

In Section 9 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006, it is provided that whoever, being a male adult above eighteen years of age, contracts a child marriage shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to one lakh rupees or with both.

In this view of the matter, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.

However, the Court hereby issues directions to State of Punjab to examine and consider the case of petitioners and if it is found that there is real and genuine threat to their life, limb and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 then they will be provided protection forthwith. If the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided facility of Protection Home as per their requirement. However, this order shall not be applicable in case any act / conduct of any of the petitioners pertaining to the application, amounts to an offence.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
