The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the photocopies of affidavit of respondents No.4 to 6 in which they stated that as petitioner No.1-Jyoti Rani is living happily with petitioner No.2-Pardeep, they have no objection with their marriage and they do not apprehend any threat to them.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case any of the petitioners apprehend any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa and in that eventuality, be provided protection as prayed for.
