DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.372, dated 22.08.2016, registered under Sections 365 & 506 IPC and added later on Sections 302, 364, 201, 120-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR and he has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused Mubbin who has been released on regular bail. Learned counsel also submits that petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2016 and out of total thirty four witnesses twenty eight have been examined. Remaining witnesses are to be examined and thereafter statement of the accused and defence witnesses are to be

examined. No purpose would be served by keeping him in the custody.

Learned State counsel submits that twenty seven witnesses have been examined and four have been given up. He has not disputed the custody period and the fact that co-accused Mubbin has been released on regular bail.

Heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the contents of the FIR.

Admittedly, the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement and co-accused has been released on regular bail. Petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2016. The trial of the case would take long time to conclude as not only prosecution witnesses are to be examined but defence witnesses remain to be examined as well.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
