The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from respondents No. 4 and 5 and to initiate legal proceedings against them.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife (respondent No. 5). Respondent No. 4 is adding fuel to the fire and is threatening the petitioner. Despite representation dated 21.07.2018 (Annexure P-3), the senior police officials are not taking any action thereupon.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 21.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) and

to take appropriate action thereupon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
