This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 436, 427, 353, 186, 188, 148, 149, 120-B read with Sections 3 & 4 of the Prevention of Damages to Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 and 4 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908, at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, Distt. Mansa, vide FIR No.73 dated 25.08.2017.

Petitioners are stated to be in custody for more than five months. Allegations are that they instigated co-accused to commit crime. Investigation has been completed and challan has been presented before the trial court. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
