Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR no.28 dated 10.01.2018, registered under Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 18(c) and 18A of Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940 at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 10.01.2018. He does not have any criminal antecedents. The investigation in this case is complete but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Thus, the petitioner be granted regular bail.

3. Custody certificate dated 19.09.2018, prepared by Varun Sinwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Sirsa, Haryana, has been filed in Court and is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. The prayer is opposed by learned State counsel. He however does not contradict the fact that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and that no PW has been examined till date.
5. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has suffered incarceration of almost nine months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as well as the fact that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.
5. Accordingly, petition is allowed and the petitioner-Ginder Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
