This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.5 dated 24.5.2016 under sections 409, 420, 120-B I.P.C and sections 13(1)(d) read with section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Vigilance Bureau, FS-1, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Allegations in a nutshell are with regard to leakage of papers pertaining to recruitment to different posts under PUNSUP.

As per prosecution version, the residential premises of the present petitioner was being used for showing the papers to the prospective candidates.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh submits that petitioner had joined investigation and the investigation process having concluded even the challan stands presented.

It has also gone uncontroverted that other co-accused who were either the beneficiaries of having knowledge of the leaked papers or such accused who had allegedly acted as conduits and taken the prospective

candidates to Lucknow, where the contents of the leaked papers were shown to the prospective candidates, have been granted concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above and without making any observations on merits, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. The order dated 4.9.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
