Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 27.11.2012 registered under Section 18 of NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.6, Industrial Area, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Varinder Kumar, has produced photocopy of order dated 08.08.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender after expiry of 30 days from the date of publication of proclamation. He states that the order nowhere suggests that the petitioner has surrendered/appeared before the trial Court on 08.08.2018. He further states that once the petitioner has been declared as PO, his anticipatory bail application is also not maintainable.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition.
