SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is one of the accused in F.I.R No.38, dated 11.03.2010, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Compromise (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rupnagar, vide report dated 29.09.2017, in connected case being CRM-M-18272-2017 titled “Sarabjit Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and another”, has apprised this Court

that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent No.2 is represented by his Counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

[4]. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rupnagar, in connected case being CRM-M-18272-2017 and in view of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.38, dated 11.03.2010, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
