In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.274 dated 25.11.2015 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Contonment, Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he had benefit of bail for want of FSL report. Thereafter, non-bailable warrants had been issued on 24.05.2018.

3. Learned State counsel submitted that having regard to the conduct of the petitioner with reference to zimny order dated 09.03.2018, 22.03.2018, 16.04.2018, 24.05.2018, 23.07.2018, petitioner is not entitled for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. Perusal of the aforesaid dates and events relating to presence of the petitioner before the trial court, it is evident that from 09.03.2018 to 23.07.2018, petitioner remained absent before the trial court. Having regard

to the aforesaid conduct of the petitioner, he is not entitled for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
