File received back from Mediation and Conciliation of this Court. Parties have arrived at amicable settlement. Petitioner No.2 shall remain bound by the terms of settlement.

Learned counsel for private respondents submits that private respondents will not pose any threat to life and liberty of the petitioners. Their only concern is about welfare of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for petitioners confines the relief claimed in this petition for direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of above submission of learned counsel for petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the representation dated

31.07.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with representation in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
